The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Tuesday, January 27, 2009, between the hours of 6:00 PM and 7:30 PM in the Recreation Room of the Oak Grove Baptist Church, located at 28 Lakey Creek Road, Franklin.

Interested individuals may attend this informal workshop at their convenience during the above stated hours. Department of Transportation representatives will display maps. A presentation of the project and alternatives studied will begin at 6:00 with a question and answer session following.

This project calls for replacing the structurally deficient Bridge Number 172 in Macon County with a new structure. The project proposes to replace the existing bridge on new location downstream from its existing location. There are currently two alternatives under consideration. During construction, traffic will be maintained on the existing structure. NCDOT apologizes for any inconveniences and will work to minimize construction time. Proposed improvements will require additional right of way.
