

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING  
FOR THE PROPOSED TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS TO  
NC 24 FROM SR 1238 MCLEMORE ROAD NEAR SNOW HILL TO I-40**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold a pre-meeting open house and design public meeting at the following time and place only on half of the project:

Pre-Meeting Open House - 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.  
Presentation – 7:00 p.m.  
Sunset Avenue School (formerly Sampson Middle School)  
505 Sunset Avenue, Clinton, 28328**

**NCDOT representatives** will be available in an informal setting for the duration of the pre-meeting open house to answer questions and receive comments relative to the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions also will be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours.

**The formal public meeting will follow the pre-meeting open house.** The meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m. The presentation will consist of an explanation of the proposed design, the state - federal relationship, right of way and relocation requirements/procedures. The meeting will be open to those present for statements, questions and/or comments. The presentation and comments will be recorded and a transcript will be prepared.

**This project proposes to** widen existing NC 24 from SR 1238 McLemore Road near Snow Hill in Sampson County to I-40 in Duplin County. The project calls for a four-lane median divided roadway with a full controlled access interchange at I-40. Portions of the project on new location will have limited control of access. Widening portions will have partial control of access. Additional right of way and the relocation of homes and businesses will be required for this project.

**Maps only showing** the proposed design of the second half of the project are available for public review at City Hall, 221 Lisbon St. Clinton, 28329 and at the NCDOT District Office, 220 North Boulevard, Clinton, 28328. The maps for the entire project may be viewed online at the NCDOT Roadway Design website. Scroll down to Cumberland County. The first half of the project is on maps 1 – 6. The second half of the project is on maps 7 – 11. Meetings were held on the first half of the project this past summer.
