NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Subject: Invitation to Bid on Purchase Order Contracts

Project Description: Surfacing, Resurfacing, And Widening On Various Roads Upon Request.

The North Carolina Department of Transportation is requesting bids for the following counties:

Edgecombe, Halifax, Nash, Wilson, Wayne, Johnston (East of I-95), and Johnston (West of I-95).
Each county will be bid as a separate project.

The terms of these contracts shall be effective upon notification by the Department that the purchase order has been approved. For Edgecombe, Halifax, Johnston (East of I-95), and Johnston (West of I-95) the contracts will remain in effect until June 30, 2010. For Nash and Wilson, the contracts will remain in effect until June 30, 2011.

Sealed Bids must be received in the Division Office at 509 Ward Blvd., Wilson, NC 27893 by **2:00 PM** on **Tuesday July 21, 2009**. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposals and display the following statement on the front of the envelopes:

"Quotation for Tier Paving in (County Name) in Division 4"
