The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Thursday, August 7, 2008, between the hours of 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM in the Cumberland County Public Library Headquarters - the Pate Room, 300 Maiden Lane, Fayetteville, 28301.

Interested individuals may attend this informal workshop at their convenience during the above stated hours. Department of Transportation representatives will display maps and will be available to answer questions and receive comments from the public. There will be no formal presentation.

This project proposes to replace Bridge No. 125 over Cross Creek on NC 24-210 (Grove Street) in Fayetteville. The purpose and need of the project is to replace the structurally deficient and functionally obsolete bridge with a new structure. Traffic will be maintained through the area during construction of the new structure. Proposed improvements may require additional right of way.
