

**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING ON  
PROPOSED TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS TO RAMSEY STREET (US 401)  
FROM COUNTRY CLUB DRIVE (US 401 BYPASS) TO INTERSTATE 295**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold a Public Meeting with an Open House session on August 28, 2008 at the College Lakes Recreation Center, 4945 Rosehill Road, Fayetteville, 28311.

Department of Transportation representatives will be available during the Open House session between the hours of 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. to answer questions and receive comments relative to the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will also be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours.

A formal presentation will begin at 7:00 p.m. The presentation will consist of an explanation of the proposed design and access management practices. The meeting will be open to those present for statements, questions and/or comments. A transcription of the presentation and comments will be taken.

The purpose of this meeting is to present information, answer questions, and receive comments regarding the proposed design modifications to the existing five (5) lane roadway. NCDOT proposes to install a landscaped median with median openings in the center turn lane on Ramsey Street (US 401) from Country Club Drive (US 401 Bypass) to I-295 to improve safety and traffic operations. The project is about 3.3 miles long. Additional right of way will be required to accommodate the proposed improvements.
