The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Tuesday, June 10, 2008, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at Martin Community College, Building 1 - Room 14, located at 1161 Kehukee Park Road, Williamston, 27892.

NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal setting to answer questions and receive comments about the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions also will be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. No formal presentation will be made.

NCDOT proposes improvements along the Corridor including railroad crossing surface upgrades, realignments, and the closure of two railroad crossings; one at Cullipher Road (SR 1410) and one at Slade Street in Williamston. The proposed closures are part of an effort to reduce the number of redundant and/or unsafe rail-highway at-grade crossings statewide.
