

NOTICE OF A CITIZENS INFORMATIONAL WORKSHOP ON THE  
PROPOSED INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS ALONG US 220 BUSINESS

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold a Citizen Informational Workshop on February 10, 2009 between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Asheboro Public Works Building, 1312 North Fayetteville Street, Asheboro, 27204.

NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments relative to the intersections improvements. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above-mentioned hours. Please note there will be no formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes to improve intersections along sections of US 220 Business (North Fayetteville Street); in Asheboro from SR 2269 (Vision Drive) to SR 2173 (Underwood Street) and SR 2149 (Hub Morris Road) to SR 1712 (Pineview Street); in Randleman at US 220 Business (South Main Street) and US 311 Extension. The purpose of the project is to improve safety. Additional right of way and the relocation of homes and businesses will be required.
