

NOTICE OF A CITIZENS INFORMATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR
THE PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO THE I-485/I-85 INTERCHANGE

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Thursday, February 5, 2009, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of Mallard Creek High School located at 3825 Johnston-Oehler Road, Charlotte, 28269.

Interested individuals may attend this workshop at their convenience during the above stated hours. The purpose of this workshop is for NCDOT representatives to provide information, answer questions, and accept written comments regarding this project. Please note there will be no formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes to modify the interchange at Interstate 485 (I-485) and Interstate 85 (I-85). The purpose of the project is to connect the remaining section of I-485 with I-85 and the existing I-485, thus completing the Charlotte Outer Loop. NCDOT will be presenting preliminary design alternatives for the interchange. Additional right of way **may** be required for this project.
