

**Warren County DOT Planning Committee  
Summary – July 25, 2006**

1. Present at this meeting were Linda Jones, John Church, Walter Gardner, Chuck Browne, Michael Humphries, Shelby Powell, Sara Sherman, Scott Walston, and Rupal Desai
2. Review of last meeting: Major topics from the June 27<sup>th</sup> meeting were reviewed. The confusion on the correct name for different portions of SR 1345 (Old Macon Hwy and/or Eaton Ferry Rd) was discussed. Also, a potential safety location was noted as the crossover between Halifax Electric and Old Macon Highway.
3. Survey Results: Shelby handed out the Survey Monkey results and also gave a presentation with graph displays of the results. The results will be gone over in detail to make sure that locations identified by the public are included in the study. Shelby will get pdf files of the results and presentation to Sara to put on the internet. Sara will distribute that link to group members so everyone can view it.
4. Traffic Projections: At this time no more adjustments to the future year traffic projections were indicated. Sara will contact Cassandre' to see if she has any further information that would help justify/adjust these projections. Sara will carry these numbers forward and begin to work on the Highway Capacity Deficiencies Map. This map will be in Draft form and the group will have the opportunity to comment and make adjustments.
5. Bicycle Deficiencies/Goals: The group looked at a map showing existing routes in the county. They identified areas that could benefit from better on-road bicycle facilities. The top 3 items identified were:
  1. Access to parks
  2. Access to lakes
  3. Connecting the 3 municipalitiesOther items identified were a Dirt Bike facility, a golf course, and an annual bike race that comes up from Raleigh on US 401.
6. Other items: Also mentioned at this meeting was the funding/construction schedule of US 158. Sara will bring the most up-to-date information she has to the next meeting. It was also noted that the 2007-2013 Draft TIP (the state's funding schedule) is anticipated to be released sometime in August (or near then) and that information will be provided to the group when it is available. The new TIP may change the current schedule for US 158.
