

**Warren County DOT Planning Committee  
Summary – May 23, 2006**

1. Present at this meeting were Linda Jones, Carroll Harris, Chuck Browne, Michael Humphries, Susan Brown, Shelby Powell, Sara Sherman, Scott Walston, Byron Sanders, Phil Lanier, and Rupal Desai.
2. US 158 Info Sheet: This was an informational item that Sara distributed. She got it from a meeting held by the Project Development Engineer, Jennifer Fuller. It shows the most recent project schedule. Sara highlighted that Citizens workshops are scheduled to begin late this year.
3. Level of Service (LOS): A decision was made to choose LOS C for the Warren County CTP. This decision will factor into the calculated capacities for network roads.
4. Traffic Projections: Sara got input on her initial traffic projection estimates. The followed issues were brought up with input from the group:
  - I-85 – growth rate will be raised
  - NC 903 – growth rate will be raised
  - SR 1306 (Wise-Five Forks Rd) – Error found in table, will be filled in
  - SR 1344 (Eaton Ferry Rd) – growth rate will be raised.Also during this discussion there was some confusion about SR 1318, 1345, and 1344 and the fact they were all listed as Eaton Ferry Rd. For clarification, the only portion of SR 1318 that is a study network road is the small portion between SR 1345 and SR 1344. SR 1345 turns directly off of US 158 in Vaughn. These 3 roads together form 1 continuous route, Eaton Ferry Rd, up to Lake Gaston. SR 1318 east of SR 1344 is named Old Macon Hwy, but the small portion marked for study (west of SR 1344) is correctly listed as Eaton Ferry Rd.

Sara will send out the updated tables of traffic projections with her reminder for the next meeting.
5. Surveys: Group members who were able picked up completed surveys from their locations before the meeting. Shelby noted that as of that morning 40 had been completed online. The survey ends June 15, so after that date members will need to go to their locations and collect all the surveys. Sara will send out a reminder to do in her email reminder about the next meeting.
6. Next Meeting: June 27<sup>th</sup> @ 10:00am. We will continue input on future year traffic projections.
