



NC Interagency Leadership Team (ILT) Strategic Plan

Goal 1: Develop a shared, comprehensive Geographic Information System (GIS) database

- A. Identify and communicate GIS needs to the Geographic Information Coordinating Council
- B. Identify the priority of the updated GIS data layers so available funding can be appropriated to those needs
- C. Utilize GIS on 3 “pilot” transportation projects to show the effectiveness and efficiency of advancing the use of GIS in the project development process
- D. Ensure future surveys and delineations performed by ILT agencies are incorporated into NC OneMap
- E. Annually develop and submit a coordinated list of prioritized needs, as related to the ILT’s Goals, in support of agencies’ budget requests

Goal 2: Partner with local governments and other stakeholders to integrate local use and long-range transportation planning, as well as applicable environmental and economic planning initiatives, to meet mobility, economic, and environmental goals

Integrate Long-Range Planning with NEPA

- A. Implement Comprehensive Transportation Planning (CTP)/Integration initiative with agencies, Metropolitan Planning Organizations, Rural Planning Organizations, Federal Highway Administration and NC Department of Transportation and ensure that activities are pursued to successfully implement the CTP/Integration Process
- B. Develop lessons learned from Brunswick County CTP process and report back to ILT

Climate Change

- C. The ILT will communicate to internal and external stakeholders the challenges created by climate change in order to raise awareness
- D. The ILT will work with stakeholders in vulnerable areas of NC to develop strategies for adaptation to climate change

Goal 3: Improve the Merger 01 Process

- A. Review the effectiveness of the Merger OQ Process in order to identify strengths and areas that need improvement and address those areas needing improvement
- B. Investigate program efficiencies/streamlining to enable agencies to focus on broader conservation efforts and accelerate transportation project delivery
